“ALMA A. GLENZ MEDICAL SCHOLARSHIP”

Biographical Information:

Alma A. (Strasburg) Glenz was born in Eau Claire County on December 11, 1908. She graduated from Fall Creek High School in 1927 and then attended Kahler Hospital School of Nursing in Rochester, MN, graduating in 1931. Alma was a very dedicated nurse at Luther Hospital in Eau Claire for many years. She also was active in the St. John's Lutheran Church in Eau Claire; working in the clothing bank there. She passed away at the age of 92 on September 8, 2001. This scholarship has been made possible through donations from her daughter, Beverly (Glenz) Knudtson (FCHS Class of '54) and her son in law Donald Knudtson (FCHS Class of '52).

Qualification Criteria:

1. Applicant must be a graduating senior attending Fall Creek High School.
2. Student must rank in the top 50% of their senior class.
3. Candidates must not be the recipient of any other major scholarships.

Scholarship Payment:

1. Scholarship checks will be made payable to the **recipient and school** by the Treasurer of the Fall Creek Area Foundation and mailed to the recipient's home or current address.
2. The recipient must provide grade transcripts to the Foundation Treasurer as proof of successful completion of each semester's course of study prior to payment.
3. Payment schedule is as follows:
 - One-half to be paid at the end of the first semester of study.
 - Second-half to be paid at the end of the second semester of study.
