**Qualification Criteria:**

1. Applicant must be a graduating senior attending Fall Creek High School.
2. Student must be ranked in the top 60% of their graduating class.
3. Interested students must be planning a post secondary course of study at an accredited institution (university or technical college).
4. Applicants must not be a recipient of the four year Academic Scholarship.
5. Applicants must have participated in at least one (1) Lions Club community service project.
6. Applicants who are Lions members, or are related to a past or present Lions member shall be given precedence.

**Application Requirements:**

1. Application deadline is 3:15 PM, March 8, 2016.
2. Interested students should present a resume listing membership or relationship to a Lions member, career goals, volunteer experience with a Lions service project, extracurricular activities, and an essay of 500 words or less on the following topic: Why community service is important.
3. Please proofread your submission to ensure correct spelling, grammar, and sentence structure.
4. Preference may be given to submissions that are NOT cut and pasted for multiple applications.

**Scholarship Payment:**

1. Scholarship checks will be made payable to the **recipient and school** by the Treasurer of the Fall Creek Area Foundation and mailed to the recipient's home or current address.
2. The recipient must provide grade transcripts to the Foundation Treasurer as proof of successful completion of each semester's course of study prior to payment.
3. Payment schedule is as follows:
  - One-half (\$625) to be paid at the end of the first semester of study.
  - Second-half (\$625) to be paid at the end of the second semester of study.
4. The recipient must submit a grade transcript to the Foundation Treasurer, or make a written request for an alternative payment schedule, by December 31, 2017. Failure to comply will mean forfeiture of the scholarship.
