“GERT ZIEMANN BUSINESS SCHOLARSHIP”

Biographical Information:

Gertrude Ziemann’s life spanned three centuries. She was born in Fall Creek on October 31, 1900, at the close of the 19th century, and died in Eau Claire on January 1, 2001, at the beginning of the 21st century. She was among the earliest graduates of Fall Creek High School. Gertrude spent her working career at the State Bank of Fall Creek. She traveled extensively, and built one of the first cottages on Lake Eau Claire after the dam was constructed as a W.P.A. project.

Qualification Criteria:

1. Applicant must be a graduating senior attending Fall Creek High School.
2. The student must be ranked in the top 60% of their senior class.
3. Applicants must be planning a post secondary course of study in business or any of the wide-ranging and various programs relating to the business field.

Scholarship Payment:

1. Scholarship checks will be made payable to the **recipient and school** by the Treasurer of the Fall Creek Area Foundation and mailed to the recipient’s home or current address.
2. The recipient must provide grade transcripts to the Foundation Treasurer as proof of successful completion of the first semester’s course of study prior to payment.
3. Payment will be made at the end of the first semester of study.
