Qualification Criteria:

1. Applicant must be a graduating senior attending Fall Creek High School.
2. The student must be ranked in the top 60% of their senior class.
3. The Applicant must plan a post secondary course of study at an accredited institution.

Scholarship Payment:

2. The recipient must provide grade transcripts to the Foundation Treasurer as proof of successful completion of the first semester's course of study prior to payment.
