**“RHONDA WEBSTER MEMORIAL EARLY CHILDHOOD
DEVELOPMENT SCHOLARSHIP”**

Biographical Information:

Rhonda was born April 25, 1953 in Eau Claire, Wisconsin. She grew up in the Augusta Area and graduated from Augusta High School in 1971. She received an Associate Degree from CVTC in Haute Cuisine. Rhonda met George Webster while cooking at the Baliwick Supper Club in Osseo. They married in 1974, initially living in Augusta, but later settling in the Town of Lincoln to raise their two children, Lee and Tonya. After the children were born, she volunteered at the Fall Creek Schools in a variety of capacities and subsequently was employed there as an Elementary, Special Education, and Kindergarten aid for 30 years. She also was a part of providing Before School, Lunchroom and Playground Supervision, and coordinating the Safety Patrol student crossing guards. Rhonda loved cooking, flowers and gardening, as well as singing in Church, Gospel, and Madrigal choirs.

Qualification Criteria:

1. Applicant must be a graduating senior attending Fall Creek High School.
2. The recipient must be planning to study early childhood development and attend an accredited college, university, or technical college. (This includes a two (2) semester childcare certificate course, as well as Education or Early Education courses serving children birth through 3rd grade.)

Scholarship Payment:

1. Scholarship checks will be made payable to the **recipient and school** by the Treasurer of the Fall Creek Area Foundation and mailed to the recipient's home or current address.
2. The recipient must provide grade transcripts to the Foundation Treasurer as proof of successful completion of the first semester's course of study prior to payment.
3. Payment will be made at the end of the first semester of study.
4. The recipient must submit a grade transcript to the Foundation Treasurer, or make a written request for an alternative payment schedule, by December 31, 2020. Failure to comply will mean forfeiture of the scholarship.
