“RICHARD ZIEMANN STEM SCHOLARSHIP”

Biographical Information:

Richard Ziemann is a Fall Creek area supporter through and through. He grew up in Fall Creek, graduated from Fall Creek High School in 1961, went on to graduate from the University of Wisconsin Madison School of Pharmacy in 1966, and worked at Lehman Drug until retirement in 2002. Richard was a founding member of the Fall Creek Area Foundation and served on the Board of Directors from 1990 until 1999. Richard also served the Fall Creek community as a member of the Village Board for nine years, Board President for four years, and has been an active member of the Fall Creek Lions Club since 1973. Richard represented the Fall Creek area on the Eau Claire County Board for 10 years.

Qualification Criteria:

1. Applicant must be a graduating senior attending Fall Creek High School.
2. All applicants must be planning to study in any program relating to science, technology, engineering, or mathematics at any Wisconsin college, university or technical school.

Scholarship Payment:

1. Scholarship checks will be made payable to the **recipient and school** by the Treasurer of the Fall Creek Area Foundation and mailed to the recipient's home or current address.
2. Students must be accepted and enrolled in a post secondary course of study at an accredited institution in Wisconsin.
3. The recipient must provide grade transcripts to the Foundation Treasurer as proof of successful completion of each semester's course of study prior to payment.
4. Payment schedule is as follows:
 - One-half to be paid at the end of the first semester of study.
 - Second-half to be paid at the end of the second semester of study.
