“ROBERT ZIEMANN HEALTH CARE SCHOLARSHIP”

Biographical Information:

Robert “Bob” Ziemann was born on June 15, 1923. He is a lifelong resident of Fall Creek. He served in the United States Navy during World War II as a Fire Controller in the Pacific Theatre. Upon completing his service, Bob worked as a plumber and electrician for the family business, Ziemann’s Hardware. He was a member of the Fall Creek Fire Department for 33 years and has been a member of the American Legion for the past 50 years.

Qualification Criteria:

1. Applicant must be a graduating senior attending Fall Creek High School.
2. Applicants must be planning to study health care at the Chippewa Valley Technical College.

Scholarship Payment:

1. The student must be accepted and enrolled in a course of health care study at the Chippewa Valley Technical College.
2. Scholarship checks will be made payable to the **recipient and school** by the Treasurer of the Fall Creek Area Foundation and mailed to the recipient’s home or current address.
3. The recipient must provide grade transcripts to the Foundation Treasurer as proof of successful completion of the first semester’s course of study prior to payment.
4. Payment will be made at the end of the first semester of study.
