Biographical Information:

Qualification Criteria:

1. Applicant must be a graduating senior attending Fall Creek High School.
2. Applicant must be in the top 50% of class
3. Applicant must be accepted to attend an accredited university, college or technical school in the State of Wisconsin with Preference given to an applicant choosing to attend UW-Stout.

Scholarship Payment:

1. Scholarship checks will be made payable to the **recipient and school** by the Treasurer of the Fall Creek Area Foundation and mailed to the recipient's home or current address.
2. Students must be accepted and enrolled in a post-secondary course of study at an accredited institution.
3. The recipient must provide grade transcripts to the Foundation Treasurer as proof of successful completion of each semester's course of study prior to payment.
4. Payment schedule is as follows:
 - One-half to be paid at the end of the first semester of study.
 - Second-half to be paid at the end of the second semester of study.
