

## **RICHARD ZIEMANN STEM SCHOLARSHIP**

### **Qualification Criteria:**

1. Applicant must be a graduating senior attending Fall Creek High School.
2. All applicants must be planning to study in any program relating to science, technology, engineering, or mathematics at any Wisconsin college, university or technical school.

### **Application Requirements:**

1. Application deadline is 3:15 PM, March 1, 2024.
2. Interested students should submit a copy of your official high school transcript showing your overall grade point average, and also a copy of your ACT score sheet showing composite, math, science, and STEM scores.
3. Applicants should provide the post-secondary school that you plan to attend, the course of study including Major/Minor, and the type of work or position you are presently interested in after graduation from post-secondary school.
4. List activities outside of classroom work in which you have actively participated, as well as any notable achievements.
5. Please furnish any additional information you would like which you feel may help you attain this scholarship. Perhaps information about yourself and your family interests, hobbies, recreational activities, summer or after-school jobs, etc.

### **Scholarship Payment:**

1. Scholarship checks will be made payable to the **recipient and school** by the Treasurer of the Fall Creek Area Foundation and mailed to the recipient's home or current address.
2. The recipient must provide a transcript to the Foundation Treasurer as proof of successful completion of each semester's courses and enrollment in the upcoming semester.
3. Payment schedule is as follows:
  - First-half (\$1,500) to be paid at the end of the first semester of study.
  - Second-half (\$1,500) to be paid at the end of the second semester of study.
4. A written request for an alternative payment can be made to the Foundation Treasurer. All scholarships for the Class of 2024 will be distributed by the end of 2025.
5. Failure to comply with the requirements and deadlines will mean forfeiture of the scholarship.
